Transition Plan

Per your request, as transmitted via Bill Durant's memorandum of August 8, 1979, the Committee on the Handicapped reviewed and established priorities for the facility items contained in Phase II and III of the Transition Plan.

The Committee approached the prioritization of the items by considering each item individually and comparing it to every other one. The essential criteria used to establish the rank of an item were 1) whether or not it is used by the general public (including Dartmouth employees and visitors), 2) whether or not it is primarily used by only Dartmouth students, and 3) the immediacy of the need to access the facility.
