REMARKS:

Negotiations are currently being carried on between the local chapter and the national officers which may produce a change in the status of the local chapter. At the present time, however, the Dartmouth chapter cannot meet the requirements of the 1954 Referendum. If the status is not changed, the house should be required to go local by September 1, 1960, but if any change in its status does occur before that time, and if the house can them meet the Referendum requirements, this decision should be changed and the house should be re-approved for national affiliation.
